Code of Ethics

This general code is for swimmers, parents, carers, guardians, coaches and teachers, committee members and volunteers.

It should be read in conjunction with the CASC Code of Practice and Child Protection Policy.

CASC Code of Ethics

All members of the club, parents, carers and guardians will at all times:

- ✓ Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person, be they adult or child, treating everyone equally within the context of swimming;
- ✓ Respect the spirit of swimming adhering to the rules and laws in and out of the pool, incorporating the concept of friendship and respect for others;
- ✓ Promote the positive aspects of swimming and never condone the use of inappropriate or abusive language, inappropriate relationships, bullying, harassment, discrimination or physical violence;
- ✓ Accept responsibility for their own behaviour and encourage and guide all CASC members and parents, carers and guardians of junior members to accept responsibility for their own conduct and behaviour;
- ✓ Ensure that all concerns of a child safeguarding nature are referred in accordance with the CASC Child Protection Policy and Procedure;
- ✓ Conduct themselves in a manner that takes all reasonable measures to protect their own safety and the safety of others;
- ✓ Promote the reputation of swimming and never behave or encourage others to behave in a manner that is liable to bring the sport into disrepute;
- ✓ Adhere to the CASC Child Protection Policy and Procedure;
- ✓ Adhere to the CASC Equality and Diversity Policy;
- ✓ Adhere to the CASC rules and regulations; and
- ✓ Adhere to the CASC Code of Practice.
